Count 1: On or about the 23rd day of November, 2020, the crime of Manslaughter in the First Degree was feloniously committed in Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, by Corey Adams, Jared Barton, Bradley Pemberton, Bethany Sears, and Jonathan Skuta, who acting jointly, willfully, unlawfully, and unnecessarily killed Stavian Rodriguez, by shooting him with a firearm, while resisting an attempt by the deceased to commit a crime or after such attempt had failed, and thereby caused his death on the 23rd day of November, 2020, contrary to the provisions of Section 711(3) of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma
